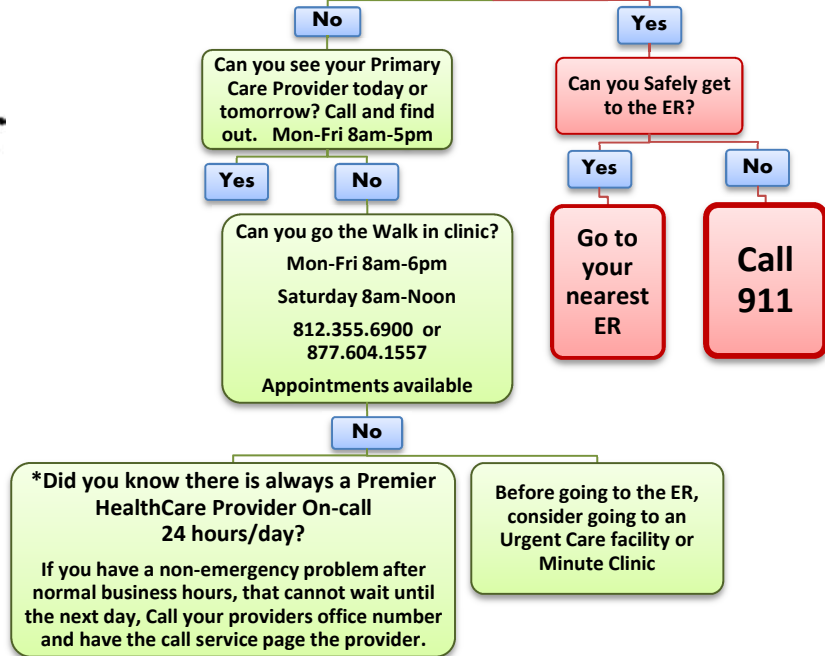

	PRIMARY CARE OR WALK IN CLINIC	EMERGENCY ROOM
Abdominal Pain:	Mild to Moderate Abdominal pain; Menstrual Pain	Severe or Moderate/Severe during Pregnancy
Allergic Reaction:	Rash/Hives	Facial swelling, Trouble swallowing or Breathing- Call 911
Animal Bites:	Insects/Ticks/ Bees/ Non emergent animal bites	Large or Poisonous animal bites, Severe Bee Sting Allergies
Back Pain:	Moderate, Chronic, or New	Severe Uncontrollable after injury, or New Severe Sudden onset
Breathing Difficulties:	Mild to Moderate Asthma or COPD	Severe Shortness of Breath- Call 911
Bladder or Urinary Tract Infection:	Mild to Moderate, painful or difficult urination.	Moderate/Severe, Unable to Urinate, Confusion/Altered Mental Status
Bleeding:	Mild to Moderate or if you are on blood thinning medication	Severe, Uncontrollable, or during pregnancy
Broken Bones:	Suspected or questionable break, sprain, or strain	Severe disfigurement or Skin is punctured
Burns:	Mild to Moderate or Blistering	Severe, Large blisters, sloughing skin
Chest Pain:	Mild with history of Angina	Severe, New, or Sudden Onset- Call 911
Cough:	Mild/Moderate; New or Chronic	Severe; Trouble Breathing, Shortness of Breath, or due to inhaled toxic fumes. - Call 911
Cuts:	Moderate with minimal bleeding , might needs stitches	Severe gaping wound needing sutures or possible surgery.
Diarrhea:	Mild to Moderate; Blood noted on tissue paper; Possibility of mild dehydration.	Severe diarrhea with bleeding and/or severe dehydration
Dizziness:	Mild to Moderate	Severe, Unable to maintain balance, Blurred Vision
Headaches:	Mild to Moderate Headaches, Chronic Severe Migraines	New Severe Sudden Onset- Call 911
Head Injury:	Mild to Moderate with No loss of Consciousness. Mild abrasion, laceration, or headache	Severe Trauma, Loss of Consciousness, Bleeding, Blurred Vision, or taking Prescription Blood thinners.
Nausea/Vomiting:	Mild to Moderate	Severe with bleeding and/or severe dehydration
Swelling:	Chronic foot, leg or ankle swelling. History Congestive Heart Failure	Facial, Neck, or Tongue swelling; Shortness of Breath
Other:	Dental Pain	Amputation
	Flu-like symptoms	Poison Ingestion
	Flu Shots or Immunizations	Overdose
	Pregnancy Tests	Shock/ Stroke Call 911
